## UNDERGROUND INTELLIGENCE

On March 16, MetroNational completed the first phase of the largest local enhanced project by a private developer in Houston. Since 2004, at an investment of nearly \$3.8 million, the company removed about 6,900 linear feet of overhead power lines, 90 power poles and numerous billboards and pylon signs. The remaining overhead power lines on the front side of Memorial City are slated to be removed by 2018.
