## POUR SOCIETY IS NOW OPEN

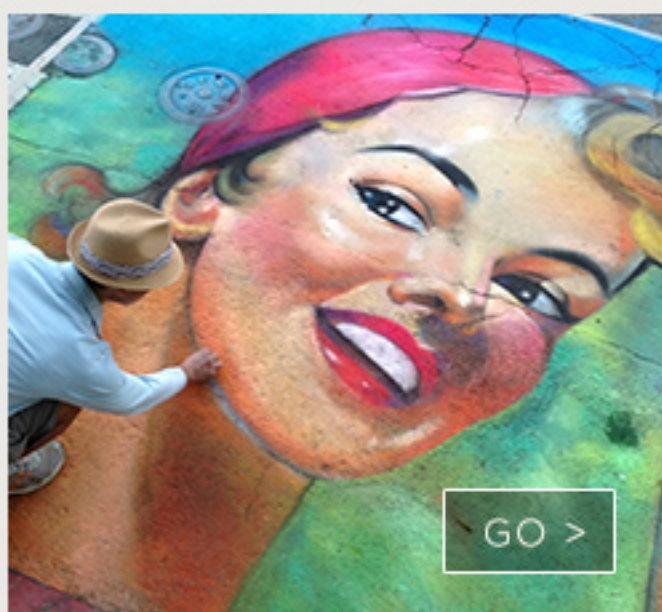

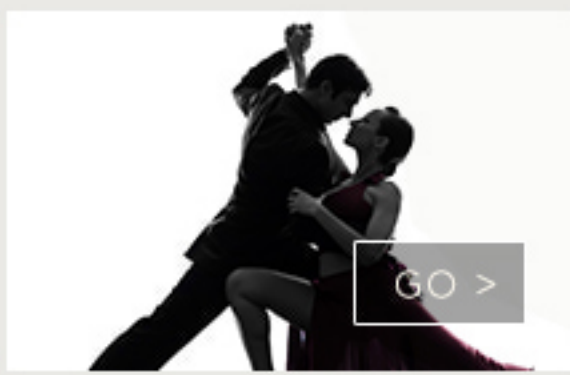

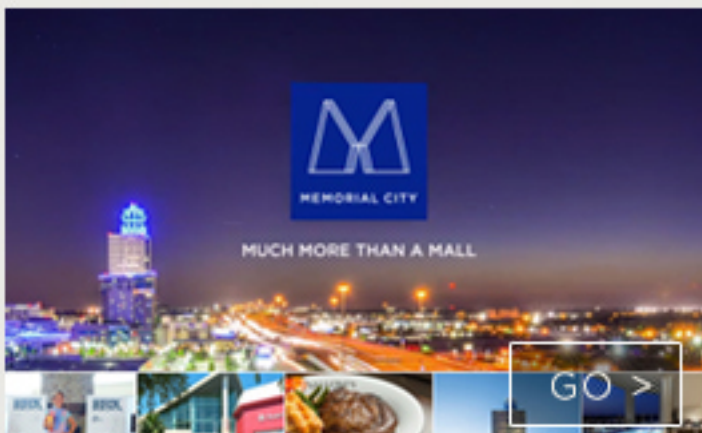
